Reynier and Catharine Quackenbush were admitted to the Kakiat DRC in West New Hempstead, NY, in the spring of 1790. Reynier was elected an Elder of the church in 1793. On 24 Feb. 1813, Letters of Administration were granted to Abraham Quackenbush in the estate of "Rinear" Quackenbush, "late of the town of Hampstead in Rockland County."

Reynier leased 194 acres of land from William Bayard on Lot 42 of the Kakiat Patent. This property now lies in the Borough of Montvale, New Jersey, although a small piece of the southeast corner is in the Township of River Vale, and the tip of the northeast corner is in New York State. In 1766 the land leased to Reynier was valued at 970 pounds and was described as:

FOURTH GENERATION

In ye field whereon ye House and Barn stands about 3 acres

Two do Northeast from ye House about 15 acres and 10 bearing apple trees

Two do North West of House abt 15 do

One do West from ye former abt 15 do

The house occupied by Reynier, a small frame structure, was later purchased by Jacobus D. Blauvelt, the next owner of the land. The house, which has had many additions in the interim, still stands at 24 North Middletown Road in Montvale, New Jersey.

The Quackenbush Family in Holland and America (1909) assigns Reynier as the son of Benjamin and Claesje (Webbers) Quackenbosch. However, because of the naming of the children above and the sponsors at their baptisms, he is assigned here to Jacob and Anna Elizabeth (Brouwer) Quackenbosch.

On 9 Nov. 1784, his two sons chose Isaac Blanch as their guardian.
